

OVERVIEW

The Beechcraft 58 Baron is a larger, more powerful version of the Baron 55. The 58 gets an extended fuselage, club seating, improved CG, and more powerful engines.

With seating for a pilot and five passengers, the 58 Baron is able to move passengers from origin to destination with ease and affordability. The 300hp Continental IO-550-C engines burn only 36 gallons per hour, giving it a range of over 1,000 nm.

With max fuel, the Baron can carry a payload of 1,464lbs with an external baggage capacity of 46 cubic feet.
