

## **OVERVIEW**

The Piper PA-28RT-201 Arrow IV is a variant of the ubiquitous Piper PA-28 Cherokee. A light, single-engined 4-seat aircraft, the Arrow features a retractable gear and a 200hp Lycoming IO-360-C1C6 engine.

The Arrow excels at flight training and personal general aviation use, thanks to its aerodynamic profile, simple systems, and straightforward avionics. A baggage door for aft storage that makes the Arrow a good choice for cross-country flying, including weekend getaways and business trips.

N2175F is a 1979 Arrow IV that's been reconditioned from prop to tail. Its engine & prop are fresh out of major overhaul. Jewel Aviation completed the engine overhaul in the fall of 2021, followed by the prop overhaul which was completed by Byam Propellers.

The exterior paint was completed in 1995, but was professionally reconditioned in 2020. On the interior, the carpet and seats were refurbished in 2004, with the headliner and side panels done in 2008. The entire interior was also professionally reconditioned in 2020.

The avionics panel is upgraded with a Garmin GNS-430W, making IFR flying near or at minimums possible. It's also ADS-B certified thanks to a Garmin GTX-327 transponder.

Piper built thousands of Cherokees and Arrows, but you'll be hard pressed to find one like N2175F. Fully reconditioned and fresh out of major overhaul, your new Arrow is ready to go have some fun!


