# **OVERVIEW**

Not only has it been protected from the elements, 75X also has been cared for by some of the most reputable shops in America, to include Chicago Beechcraft and Raytheon Beechcraft. A new modern avionics panel is currently being installed and will be ready at delivery. The pilots will love the panel, but the passengers will fight over who gets to sit on the far aft 2-place couch.


